What is Onsite University?

Onsite University offers clinical education at specified Onsite locations for the training and education of radiologic technologists who want to undergo advanced preparation to become certified and registered mammographers.

Are you a Mammographer-In-Training Candidate?

Candidates selected for the Mammographer-In-Training (MIT) program will exhibit clinical competency by demonstrating compassionate care and producing high quality imaging upon graduation.



MITs are required to take a 40-hour initial mammography training course that includes 8 hours of digital mammography and 8 hours of digital breast tomosynthesis. Completion of this course will satisfy the didactic portion of the initial training in mammography requirement as outlined in the mammography Quality Standards Act (MQSA) and the ARRT Structured Education requirement.

- ARRT required
- Minimum of one year practical experience
- Completed 40 hours initial training course in Mammography
- Must maintain CEUs as required by State and/or National accreditation bodies
- Willingness to learn and accept constructive criticism
- Possess critical thinking skills and display professional judgment

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
