1 in 8 women in the United States will develop breast cancer in her lifetime; this equates to a 13% average lifetime risk.

For women at the average risk level, annual screening mammography should start at age 40.

WHY 40?

- + Breast cancer incidence increases substantially around age 40
- + 1 in 6 breast cancers occur between 40 – 49
- + 40% of all the years of life saved by mammography are among women in their 40s

WHY ANNUALLY?

Even for women 50+, skipping a mammogram every other year would miss up to 30% of cancers

NOT ALL BREASTS ARE THE SAME...

40% of women have dense breast tissue which is normal, but puts you at higher risk of breast cancer. For these women, mammography alone may not be enough to find breast cancer.

When used in combination with mammography, Automated Breast Ultrasound (ABUS) greatly enhances detection of cancer in dense breast tissue. The procedure takes about 20 minutes and does not require compression or radiation.
