*For women at the average risk level, annual
screening mammography should start at age 40.*

WHY 40?

- + Breast cancer incidence increases substantially around age 40
- + 1 in 6 breast cancers occur between 40-49
- + 40% of all the years of life saved by mammography are among women in their 40s

WHY ANNUALLY?

Even for women 50+, skipping a mammogram every other year would miss up to 30% of cancers

WHY AT 40 AND ANNUALLY IF ONLY AT AVERAGE RISK?

3 out of 4 of women diagnosed with breast cancer have no family history or identifiable risk factors
