

BREAST CANCER STATISTICS



Annual screening mammography starting at age 40 reduces breast cancer mortality by 30%



1 IN 2 women don't get their annual breast screenings



1 IN 8 women will develop breast cancer at some point in her life



1 IN 6 breast cancers occur in women between the ages of 40–49



3 OUT OF 4 women diagnosed with breast cancer have no family history of the disease



UP TO 30% of cancers will be missed with biennial screening in women 50+ years



HALF of all women 40 years and older have dense breast tissue, which increases breast cancer risk
