1 in 8 women in the United States will develop breast cancer in her lifetime; this equates to a 13% average lifetime risk.

For women at the average risk level, annual screening mammography should start at age 40.

WHY 40?

- Breast cancer incidence increases substantially around age 40
- 1 in 6 breast cancers occur between 40-49
- 40% of years-of-life saved due to mammography are among women in their 40s

WHY ANNUALLY?

Even for women 50+, skipping a mammogram every other year would miss up to 30% of cancers

WHY AT 40 AND ANNUALLY IF ONLY AT AVERAGE RISK?

3 out of 4 women diagnosed with breast cancer have no family history or identifiable risk factors
